There will be a large charity marquee for the formal lunch with over 200 guests. It is, however, equally important to provide the opportunity for the public and members of the armed forces and their families to come to see and hear more of what is intended for the hospital and the facilities it will offer. There will be a **free** access to the grounds. Visitors may bring a picnic and can get refreshments from the club bar, which will be open to non-members.

The 1st July is also the finals day for a number of the club's major polo tournaments. This is another good reason to visit and have a great day out. The gates will be open at 11am.
